ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include, but are not limited to:

- Perform all testing in accordance with Quality Assurance Monitoring Program (QAMP).
- Documents all data and reports specification deviations to the QA Manager.
- Works together with Packaging, Batching and Brewing Supervision to troubleshoot quality issues.
- Collect samples from Packaging, Batching and Brewing areas, transport them to the lab and perform the necessary tests.
- Aseptic sample collection for micro testing and/ or customer request
- Perform chemical analysis of water, wort, beer CO₂, cleaning solutions, and brewing materials.
- Microbiological examination of beer, and yeast.
- Air, CO₂, and fill checks of filled bottles and cans as well as package integrity tests and packaging material tests when required.
- Maintaining / calibrating testing equipment.
- Reporting data, including data entry into computer and preparing records.
- Use of lab equipment including, but not limited to, Anton Paar Alcolyzer, UV spectrometer, pH meter, VDK GC, microscope, centrifuge.
- Responsible for reporting to Supervisor any observation or test result that is out-of-specification; requires the ability to analyze data and make good decisions.
- Maintain supplies in Analytical and Packaging labs.
- Monitor GMP compliance in all areas of the brewery.
- Compile essential documentation for FMB compliance to TTB rules. Work with Receiving, Brewing, Batching, Purchasing and Accounting to ensure all records are accurate and complete.
- Handle requests made by customers with regard to data gathering, sample submission, and any additional related special requests. Collection, preparation, and shipping samples as requested.
